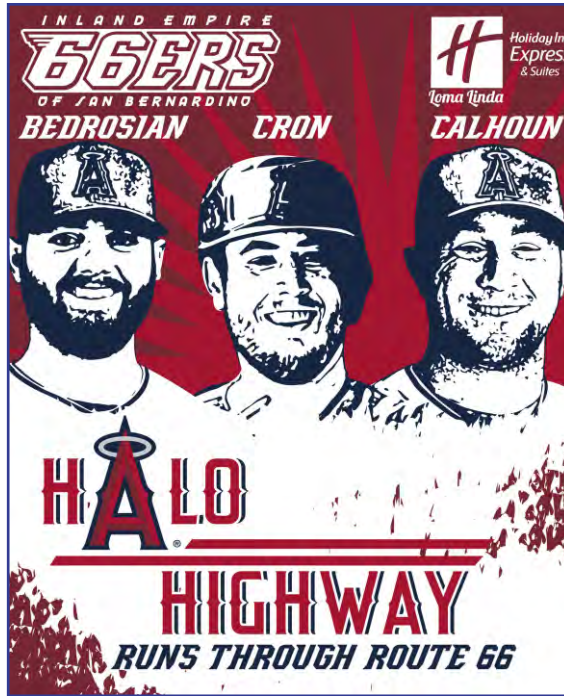

It's not only going to be time for Angels baseball but also for their affiliate the Inland Empire 66ers. They will have some promotion giveaways that will only be available if you attend their games. Some of those 2017 promotions include a Space Rebel Bernie Bobblehead Giveaway/Star Wars Night, SPAM turns 80 celebration, Halo Highway Blanket Giveaway (Kole Calhoun, CJ Cron, Cam Bedrosian on it) and a Jim Abbot Bobblehead giveaway.

At our next meeting, I will have signups for the Saturday April 29 66ers game. It is the 6th Annual DisAbilities Awareness Night/Pre-Game Baseball Clinic and Jim Abbott Bobblehead giveaway. Both patios were booked up so I have reserved the Skybox Terrace patio for the club that is on the home team side. The terrace patio will have an all you can eat barbecue same as the party patio but stays available for 2 hours as opposed to 1 hour for the party patio. The terrace patio is located right next to the suites and has seats (30) that are situated right below the terrace. Unlike the patio party, there isn't much room for tables to sit at and eat. The game starts at 6:00 and we will be able to enter at 4:30 which gives us a better chance at getting the giveaway. The terrace will cost more per person at



\$31 each (based on 30 people) but the seats have a much better view and you get the barbecue for longer. I need at least 30 people for this event. If more sign up, it will still be \$31 per person and I will still get seats in the same area. The Angels are away that night so there's no excuse for you not to come and join the party!

If the drive is too far for you, I can always try to help arrange for you to carpool with another booster. The blanket giveaway with Kole, CJ and Cam on it is on April 8 when the Angels have their second home game on that same day. If I get enough interest of at least 25 people, I will book the party patio. The cost for that game will be \$22 each with the barbecue and early

entrance. For this game I need to know at the next meeting on March 6 so that I can get the tickets to you possibly by mail or leave them at the ticket office for you.

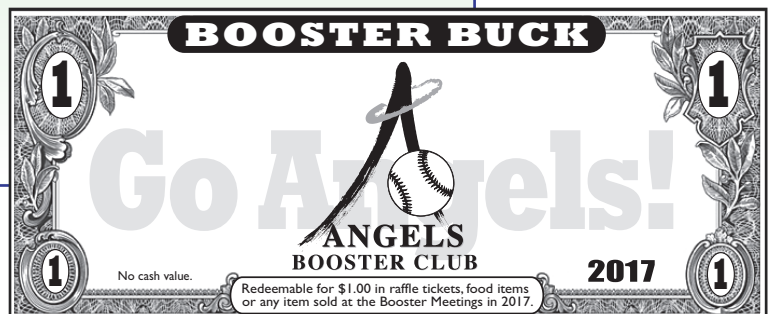
No trips are planned as of yet but I will take suggestions so look at your calendar and the Angels calendar and we'll see what we can come up with! ☺
